## **Forgot Password?**

Exciting News! A new feature has been added to Employee Self Service online. Employees now have the ability to reset their own password through Employee Self Service. To reset your password, select "Forgot Password?" You will be prompted to answer a "security question", such as identifying the last four digits of your Social Security Number. Once you've correctly answered the question, a temporary password will be emailed to the email address listed in your Employee Self Service personal information profile. Once you login using your temporary password, you will need to provide a permanent password that must be a minimum of eight characters, including one number and one special character such as: \$, %, #, @, etc. If the temporary password provided does not allow you to login and you continue to receive an error message, you may have exceeded the maximum number of login attempts allowed. You have five (5) attempts before you are locked out. You'll need to contact your department representative or OASIS Help Desk at (951) 358-6100 for assistance with your account.

You may update your primary email address in Employee Self Service under the "Personal Information" profile at any time, in addition to selecting a different security question. Please note, if you do not have a valid email address on file, you will receive an error message. If you receive an error message, please contact your Department Representative. For further assistance contact the OASIS Help Desk at (951) 358-6100 or the Benefits Hotline at (951) 955-4981. Once your password has been reset, you will need to login to Employee Self Service and provide a primary email address.

Resetting your Employee Self-Service Password

<u>Step 1:</u> Navigate to the Employee Self Service login screen (<u>https://oasishrms.oasis.lcl/</u>). If you do not remember your password, select "Forgot Password?"

<u>Step 4:</u> Retrieve your temporary password from your email (sent from OASIS\_hr@co.riverside.ca.us)and return to the Employee Self Service login page <u>https://oasishrms.oaisis.lcl</u>), enter your Employee Self Service User ID (e.g. ESS12345) and the temporary password provided in your email and then select "Sign in"

<u>Step 5:</u> Once you have successfully logged into your Employee Self Service account, using the temporary password, you will be prompted to change your password. Select the hyperlink to go to the password reset page.

The Office of the Auditor-Controller's Payroll Division would like to remind everyone that W-2 time is just around the corner. If you would like to receive your W-2 electronically and have not previously elected this method, please take the time while you are completing your Annual Enrollment via Employee Self Service, to elect to receive your W-2's electronically (if this is your preferred method of delivery). If you sign up for this option, you will no longer receive a paper W-2 in the mail. Electronic W-2's are ready for viewing before the mailed versions are printed. Therefore, if you sign up for an electronic W-2, you will be able to obtain your W-2 a few days earlier. Please note, the Auditor-Controller does not allow the forwarding of W-2's, Pay Warrants, or Pay Advices. If you move, you MUST update your address with Human Resources to ensure proper delivery of these items. There is an eight (8) day waiting period to replace lost pay warrants, per Board policy. Replacement W-2's can be requested after March 2012.
